Industrial Action 27th April 2023

Dear Parent/Carer

Given the indicative numbers of teaching staff likely to be involved in the industrial action on 27th April, we have made the difficult decision to restrict pupil attendance on this date. Attendance will be restricted to the following pupils:

- Year 11
- Identified groups in Year 12/13 (families will be notified separately)
- Vulnerable pupils
- Children of critical workers who have registered as requiring a place for their child

All other pupils will be able to access their work for the day online, via MS Teams. Pupils will know their MS Teams login details as many receive homework through this platform, however, if you or your child need further guidance regarding accessing work online, please contact the relevant Head of Year / Pastoral Manager who will be able to support you.

Lunch parcels will be made available for pupils eligible for Free School Meals. These will need to be collected from our reception area between 12.30pm and 1.30pm on the day. Parents/carers of pupils eligible for FSM will receive a link to indicate if they wish to collect a food parcel. Please ensure that you respond to allow appropriate provision to be made.

Please note, these arrangements are limited to industrial action on 27th April only. Arrangements for further planned industrial action will be reviewed and any changes will be shared with you. Our contingency planning for the strike day is available on our website.

We recognise and respect the right of our staff to take part industrial action and ask that all members of our community continue to treat each other with respect. I understand that this situation may be frustrating and apologise for any potential disruption caused.
