Here are the arrangements for the publication and collection of **all** qualification grades:

- **GCE** (for Y12 and Y13) results will be available to students on **Tuesday 18th August** from **08:00 am to 10:00 am**.
- **GCSE** results will be available to students on **Thursday 25th August** from **08:30 am to 10:30 am**.
- Students need to collect their own results and in person. No results can be given over the telephone or to a friend. However, results can be issued to an adult who has a signed consent form; the form is at the end of this letter, must be fully completed and must be signed by both the student and his/her parent/carer. The nominated adult must produce their photographic ID before results will be released to them.

All results can be collected from the Academy's restaurant at the dates and times shown above.

All students in Year 11 who have applied to join our Sixth Form are expected to attend the Sixth Form enrolment day which takes place on **Thursday 25th August** from **08:30 am to 11:00 am**. Students not able to attend this enrolment day must contact us at sixthform@keshacademy.com to make alternative arrangements.

Students in Year 11 who are still unclear about what to do after receiving their GCSE results, should also attend the enrolment day on **Thursday 25th August** from **08:30 am to 11:00 am** to access support and guidance on the options available to them.

Last but not least, I would urge all students in Year 11 whose GCSE results may not meet the entry requirements for their chosen Sixth Form courses to attend the enrolment day. They will be able to discuss alternative options and the support the Academy is able to offer.
